The Rehabilitation Unit at East Jefferson General Hospital provided rehabilitation services to 302 patients last year. Services include physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, social work/case management, rehabilitation medicine, and 24-hour rehabilitation nursing.

Competency of licensed and registered clinicians is tested annually. We do not treat patients who are ventilator dependent, have a C4 complete spinal cord injury or above, have a moderate to severe brain injury, have active TB, or patients who are under the age of 18. If the services we provide do not meet the needs of our patients, recommendations for alternative services will be made by the rehab team.


