# Can it be found early?

Breast cancers
found during screening exams are more likely
to be smaller and less likely to have
spread outside the breast.

### What are the signs?

- Skin texture changes
- 2 Visible lump
- 3 Color changes
- 4 Nipple inversion or pain
- 5 Discharge from the nipple
- 6 Dimpled skin

### Who should get tested?

- •Women 40-44 should start to consider yearly mammograms.
- •Women 45-54 should get yearly mammograms.
  - •Women 55 and older should get mammograms every two years, if otherwise healthy.

# What can I do to reduce my risk?



Get to an maintain a healthy weight.



Get moving and exercise regularly.



Avoid or limit alcohol



Breastfeed for several months after childbirth



Limit using hormone medication.
