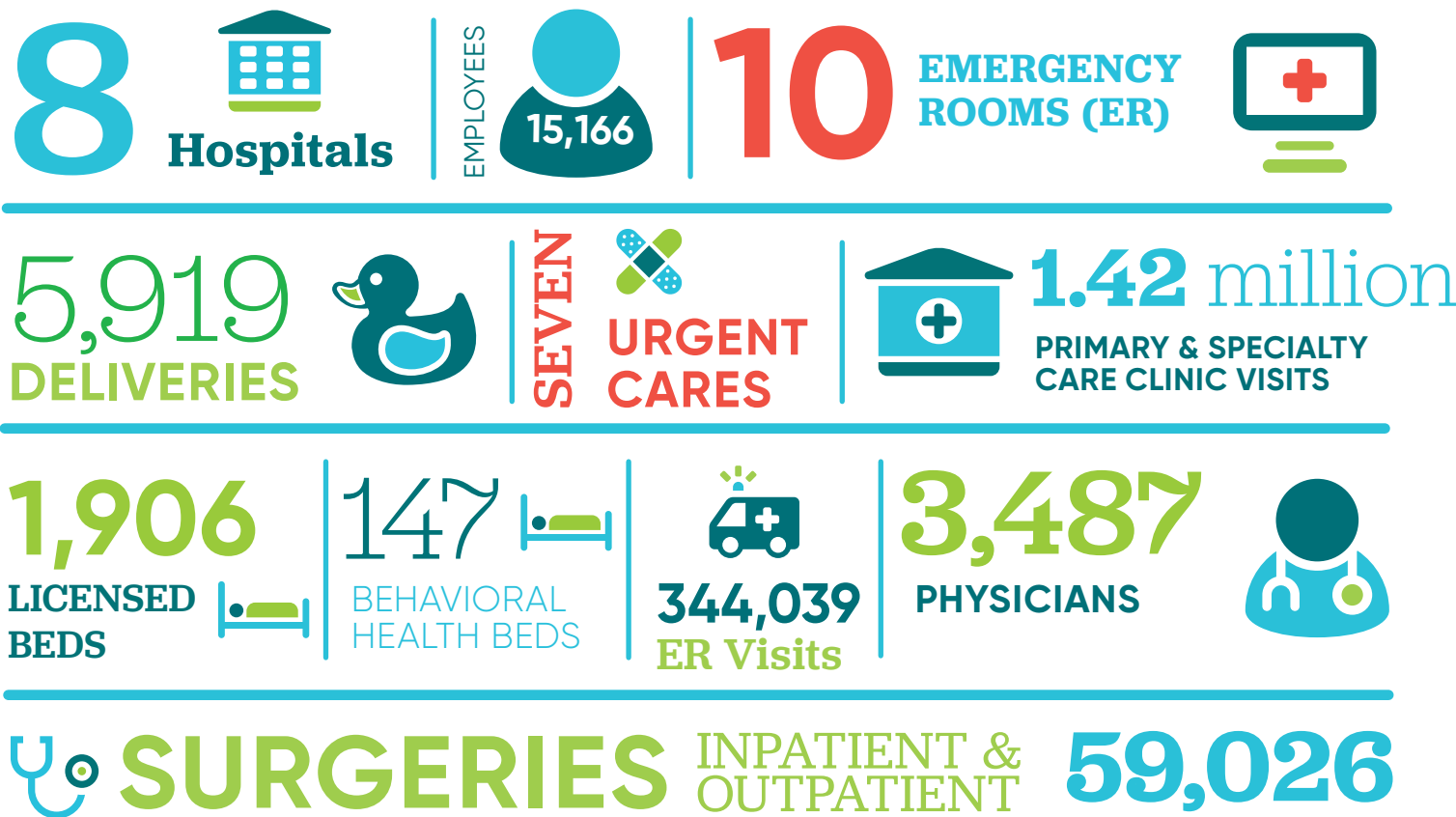

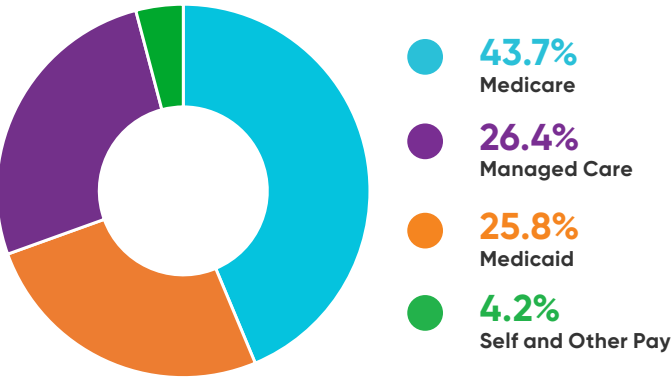
LCMC Health by the numbers
