

Partnering to make Louisiana a destination for healthcare



LCMC Health and Tulane University have announced their intent to partner to expand access to comprehensive and specialty care across Southeast Louisiana. Pending approval from the Louisiana Department of Justice, their combined structure will enhance the region's capabilities as a destination for medical innovation and training and provide community investments and benefits.

- Approximately **\$600 million commitment to downtown New Orleans**, including new construction and enhancements. This represents a one-time impact of \$1 billion on the Louisiana state economy.
- **\$220 million investment in the community** to provide best-in-class academic medical center and facility improvements.
- **\$286 million estimated annual economic impact** and potential creation of **2,300 jobs** in downtown New Orleans and throughout the state.
- **Life-saving research.** Tulane University attracts more than **\$200 million** in research funding annually, much of it devoted to finding new vaccines and treatments for infectious diseases, Alzheimer's, and other neurological disorders, hypertension, cancer, diabetes, and more.
- **Access.** Advancing health equity through more comprehensive care in downtown New Orleans and expanded hubs for specialty care in Orleans and Jefferson Parishes.
- **Education.** Establishing a new nursing program, clinical research programs, and educational spaces for students; graduate programs in public health, social work, professional advancement, and medicine, along with new space dedicated to research.
- **Innovation.** Investing in groundbreaking research, technologies, and lifesaving treatments.
- **Elevated patient care.** Creating more opportunities for comprehensive, integrated care at facilities that can support new growth and enhanced patient experiences.
