Colon cancer clinical trials

- NRG GI008 (CIRCULATE-US) Colon Adjuvant Chemotherapy Based on Evaluation of Residual Disease
 - Phase II/III trial evaluates what kind of chemotherapy to recommend to patients based on the presence or absence of circulating tumor DNA (ctDNA) after surgery for stage III colon cancer

Advanced/Recurrent

- A022101 A pragmatic randomized phase III Trial evaluating Total Ablative Therapy for Patients with Limited Metastatic Colorectal Cancer: Evaluating Radiation, Ablation and Surgery (ERASur)
 - A phase III trial comparing overall survival in newly diagnosed oligometastatic colorectal cancer treated with total ablated therapy in addition to standard of care versus standard of care alone

Early stage

Rectal cancer clinical trials

- CCTG-CO32 (NEO-RT Trial): A Phase 3 Randomized Trial of Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy, Excision and Observation versus ChemoRadioTherapy for Early Rectal Cancer
 - This study evaluates response and quality of life when chemotherapy versus chemotherapy and radiation are given before suregery for early stage rectal cancer

Early stage

Advanced/Recurrent

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 - A phase III trial comparing overall survival in newly diagnosed oligometastatic colorectal cancer treated with total ablated therapy in addition to standard of care versus standard of care alone
- A0022104 (The Janus Rectal Trial): A Randomized Phase II/III Trial Testing the Efficacy of Triplet versus Doublet Chemotherapy Regarding Clinical Complete Response and Disease Free Survival in patients with Locally Advanced Rectal cancer
 - Phase III trial evaluating mFOLFOX6 versus mFOLFIRINOX after long course adjuvant radiation for locally advanced rectal cancer
