
There is a method of significantly improving stress-induced incontinence, and our team can help by providing you with more information on the artificial urinary sphincter.

The Artificial Urinary Sphincter is placed inside the body, where the fluid filled cuff helps keep the urethra closed and a pump allows urination on demand.
